Coordinator for Sustainable Tourism Observatory in Aegean Region; originator of an academic research project [co-funded by the EU].

Since March 2015, is a member of the Board of Directors of Hellenic Republic Development Fund (HRADF), dealing -among others- with “blue growth”; member of the BoD of Thessaloniki Port Authority; HRADF’s co-ordinator for licensing the seaplanes infrastructure nationwide.
